The Association of Inner Wheel Clubs is like a wedding cake with tiers - the largest and most important layer is at grass root level with a Club, near you, in most towns and cities and large villages. These Clubs all have corresponding Rotary Clubs or sponsoring Parent Inner Wheel Club. The next tier is at District level - many Clubs together form a District. Usually a District gets its geographical location and District number from corresponding Rotary District. There are 27 Districts that make up the Association of Inner Wheel Clubs in India. The third tier is the Association, with a Governing Body called the Executive members and a Representative from each District. The fourth tier is International Inner Wheel, we have more than 1,20,000 Members in 4200 Inner Wheel Clubs in 100 Countries around me countries around the World.

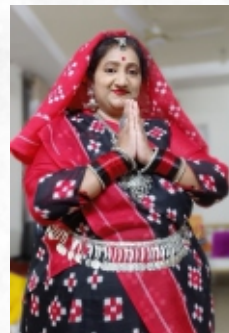
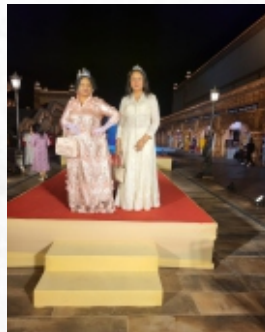

INCOMING CHAIRMAN'S INSTITUTE - AROHAN

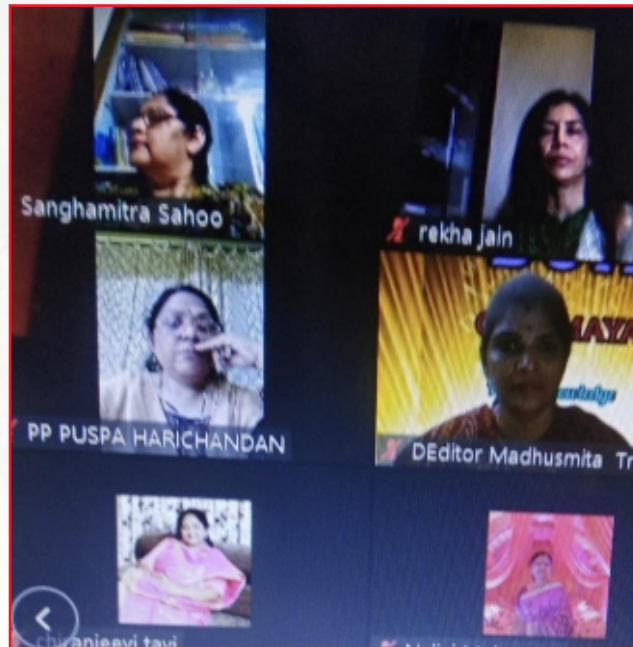
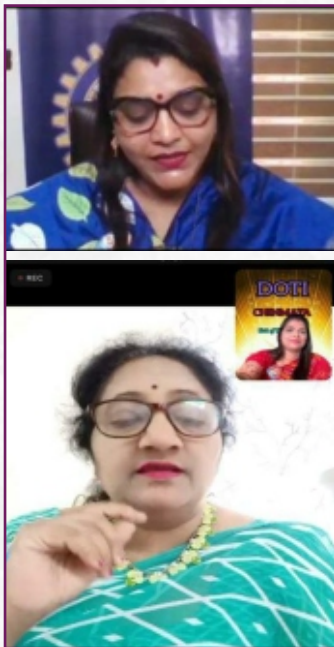
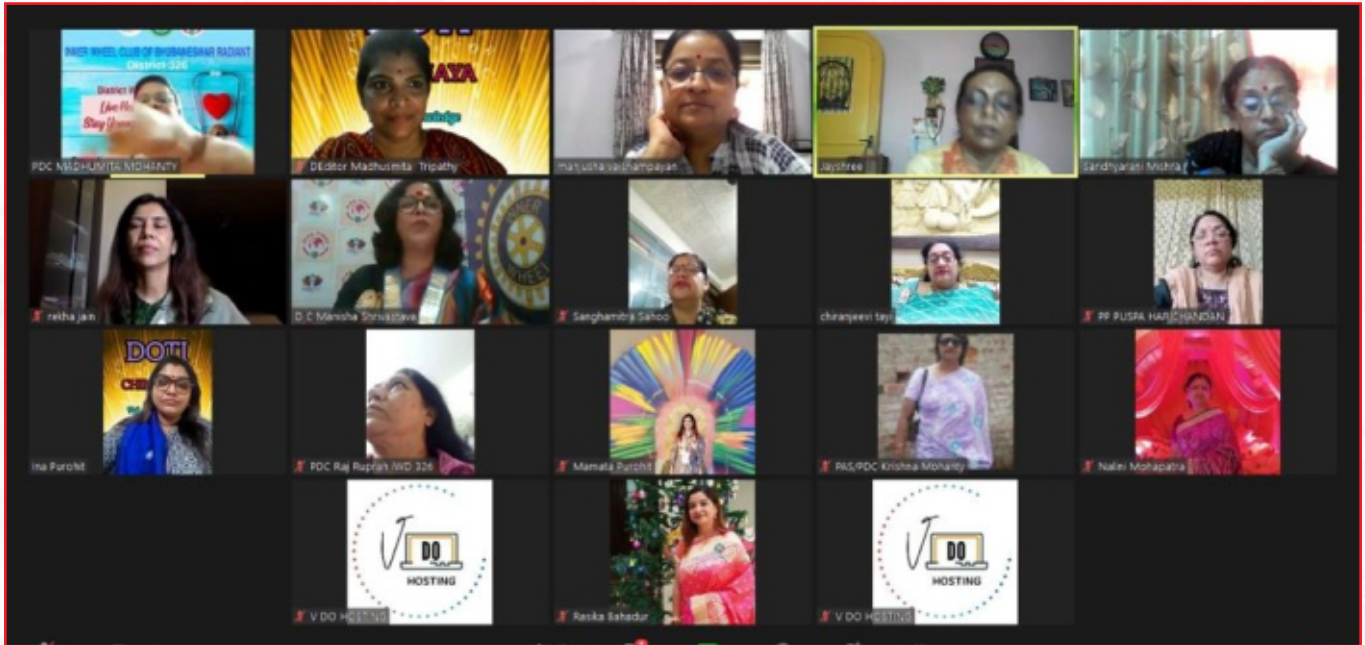

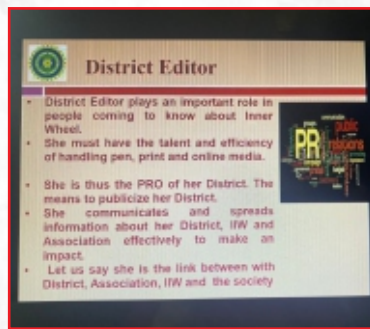
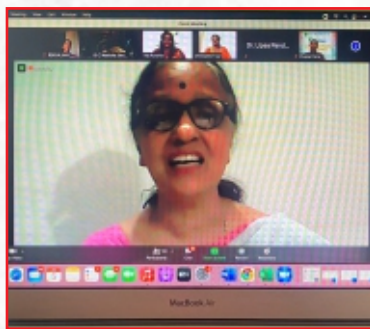
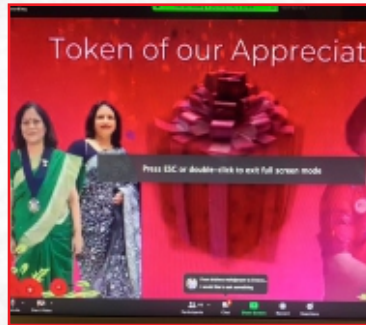
CLUB OFFICER'S TRAINING INSTITUTE - CHAITANYA 4th, 5th 6th & 8th JULY 2022

COTI DAY 2

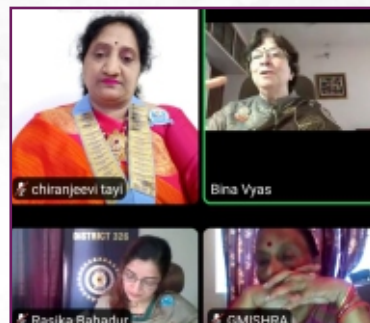
05/07/2022



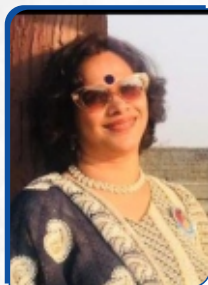

REPORT OF IPDC / ASSOCIATION COUNCIL MEMBER



With great pleasure, I present my report as AC Member for the year 2022-23 briefing the activities and achievement at Association level.

- Attended “**AAGAAZ**” Installation Ceremony of AP Dr. Surjit Kaurat Punjab Technical University, Kapurthala on 12th June 2022 hosted by District 307. Coordinated the cultural program performance and participated in “**Himanchal Night**” and won prize. Also took part in Kashmiri performance was appreciated by all members.
- Represented our District in the first Association Council Meeting held on 13th&14th June at Hotel Ramada, Kapurthala and had meaningful discussion and suggestions from AP, IPAP, CCCC, AC members, past and present Association EC Members.
- Regarding registration under 12A, Association President & NR Dr. Surjit Kaur informed that she would consult CA and hopefully sort out the matter by the year end.
- The South Asia Rally will be held in Dhaka on 26th& 27th August 2022.
- Association President & NR Dr. Surjit Kaur had received quotes regarding E-balloting from the company managing the Association website.

District Matters:

- If a Club President wants to retain for herself the copy of Association Bye laws Constitution bought for the club, **she may pay the cost to the club** and a new set can be bought for the club.
- Minutes of the AGM of the club should be **confirmed and passed** at the next G B Meeting.
- If rules conventions are passed at the District level, they should be in the **framework** of the IIW Constitution and Association Byelaws.
- **Charter from closed** clubs should be handed over to the AP during Association Council Meeting and duly recorded and minuted.
- The District can have a **PDC as ESO** to guide the District or invite a PDC as observer so that she can guide them.
- Many Presidents were confused about the format in which to report their projects. The District should advise them to report in the **IIW reporting format**; the DC or District Secretary can compile them and send them to the Association.
- This year the cost of the Association Directory will remain Rs.90. From next year, it will be sold at the **actual printing cost**, around Rs.280/- to Rs.300/-
- All those who sign the Charter Application are charter members.
- No matter what the issue you may face, **proper protocol** must be followed. Try to solve it at the club level first; if not, go to the Dist. Most probably it will be solved there. Go to the Association if necessary but not directly to IIW. The NR is the final authority.
- **Mistakes in the charter** should be brought to notice immediately. IIW will replace the charter free of cost if there is a mistake on its side, however if the mistake is by the club District, a payment of Rs.1200 will have to be made.
- Faculty coming to address ICI will be paid TA of 2nd class AC train fare. As far as possible, the same Auditor should be appointed every year to maintain continuity.
- No Districts would be bifurcated this year; there is no bifurcation request received from any of the Districts.
- The AP gave information regarding her plans, goals for the year as well as her official visits. She also mentioned that the IIW President would be the Chief Guest at the National PDC Meet to be held in Ananda hosted by D306. If any District wants her to visit them, they should contact AP & those Districts who have never hosted IIW President earlier will be given preference to Host her this year.

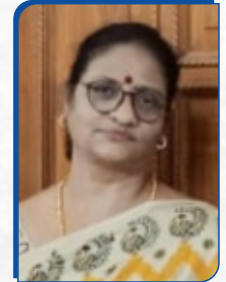
