
INTRODUCTION


- 4. All-round development activities and vocational courses for the development of children to be designed and implemented.

- 7. Empowering the Under Privileged Children through various Initiatives such as 3 A'S (Anand, Ahaar and Akshar)





WHY SMART LEARNING?





- The Annual Survey of Education Report (ASER) for elementary schools in rural India shows:
- Over 42% of class V students are unable to read class II level texts and
- Nearly 20% of class III students not recognizing numbers 1 100.
- A Report of UNICEF states- "for too many children, though, school is not always a positive experience.
 Some endure difficult conditions, like missing or inadequate teaching materials or makeshift sanitation facilities. Others lack competent teachers and appropriate curricula."
- Fusion of in person & E learning
- Flexibility of Teaching & learning hours.
- Bringing children back to school.

Smart learning is all set to drive the E-Learning Revolution in Government and Government –Aided Primary Schools, NGO Schools through a simple model:

- Provision of high quality projector and power pack sets

ADULT









Q. Who is an Adult Illiterate?

Answer: Any person 15 or 15 plus who cannot read and write.

Q. What is the minimum requirement for an Adult to be called Literate?

Answer:

- To read and Write the Alphabets in at least One language. Either Hindi or English or the Local language.
- To know digits 1 to 9.
- To know to sign or write his/her name
- Read and copy with understanding.

Aims to meet the learning needs of adults through access to appropriate learning and life skills programs. Special efforts to be provided for adults who have been deprived of early education facilities.

- Basic education equivalency
- Skill Development
- Eliminating gender disparities will by default result in increase literacy.
- Classes in regional languages

- To understand the certification process for Adult Learners
- To finance an Adult Learners Programme & Skill Training.
- To understand Responsibilities of Inner Wheel Functionaries

ACTIVITIES INCLUDED IN AN ADULT LITERACY PROJECT

- Selecting illiterate adults (15+ years), especially women & impart basic literacy
- Active participation of Inner Wheel Members
- Open Adult Literacy Centre near industrial area preferably.
- Staff education
- Continuing Education Program (CEP)
- Vocational Training for skill development/ skill up gradation



HOW TO START:





- Select a suitable venue
- Mobilize volunteers
- Select, Motivate and Counsel the adult illiterates.
- Start with the non-literate staff at your office & home.
- Select a comfortable venue to run the center.
- Take help / involve senior Inner wheel members to teach them.
- Start with verbal classes, followed by alphabet and number formation on sand with fingers.
- Give them small gifts and show appreciation on even small learning outcome from them.
- Gradually teach them to read and understand their Aadhar Card,
- Operate bank account, understand Road Signs & numbers.
