PROFILE OF MARGARETTE GOLDING

Margarette Golding was a truly remarkable woman whose vision and leadership led to the foundation of Inner Wheel, a global women's service organization. Born on November 20, 1881, in the Welsh slate-quarrying town of Blaenau Ffestiniog, she displayed extraordinary courage, foresight, intelligence, and business acumen throughout her life.

Trained as a nurse, Margarette served diligently during World War I before becoming co-owner and director of the Nurses Outfitting Association Ltd. alongside her husband, Oliver Golding. Her vital personality, sharp intellect, and exceptional ability to communicate ideas made her a highly capable businesswoman.

In Manchester, as wives of Rotary Club members began forming support groups, Margarette emerged as the driving force. She chaired the interim organizing committee and was elected Founder President of "The Inner Wheel," a name she herself coined. The official foundation date, January 10, 1924, marks the beginning of a global movement centered on friendship and service.



Margarette possessed a unique gift for inspiring friendship. An excellent speaker with a lively sense of humour, she was renowned for her warm hospitality. Her commitment to service extended beyond Inner Wheel; she was a dedicated philanthropist, notably supporting The Manchester Girls' Orphanage and Ancoats Hospital. Described as having a "heart of gold," she was known for her boundless generosity and willingness to share her time. Her understanding of human nature and unwavering faith in women fuelled her desire to create an organization where genuine friendship could flourish. She travelled extensively to promote the ideals of Inner Wheel, personalizing her visits and inspiring women across Great Britain and beyond.

By the time of her death on May 2, 1939, after battling ill health for several years, Margarette had overseen the establishment of over 150 Inner Wheel clubs. Her legacy to us: An Association of friends working together for the good of others which is being carried over by more than 120,000 members across 100 countries.

In recognition of her extraordinary contributions, the 11th International Convention in May 2000 established the Margarette Golding Award, a floral marguerite brooch, for highly commendable personal service through Inner Wheel or in the community. Her life stands as a testament to the power of friendship, service, and the enduring impact of a truly remarkable woman.

The Award may be presented for highly commendable or exceptional personal service in the local community or wider. It may be presented to:- a. a member of Inner Wheel or b. others whom the Club/District wish to honour.

When submitting an application for the above Award, please read the following instructions:-

- i. The Award is to be given to a person who has given outstanding service to the local or wider community, BUT NOT as part of Inner Wheel activities or for Inner Wheel work for which she has been elected. (The Honoured Active membership category may be a more suitable honour in those circumstances.)
- ii. The Award is not for bravery, or endurance of hardship in their personal life
- iii. The Award is not in recognition for work for which the recipient has received payment.



CRITERIA OF MARGARETTE GOLDING AWARD

The successful Margarette Golding Award recipients have

- generally been involved with a variety of charities or organisations
- for a very long time,
- often involving a great deal of commitment on a very regular basis.

Their work must be

- completely unconnected with Inner Wheel membership, Inner Wheel or Rotary fundraising activities,
- Alternatively or in addition, they must have made great personal sacrifices for the benefit of others.

The awards are given to Inner Wheel members as well as members of the general public.

The criteria for success are set high so that the award remains a truly significant marker of an individual's commitment to others.

Dr. Manjusha Vaishampayan was born in Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh, into a respected zamindar family. She is the daughter of Late Shri Manohar Rao Digraskar and Late Smt. Madhuri Digraskar. As the second child of her parents, she imbibed strong moral values from an early age, which have continued to guide her personal and professional journey.

A bright and meritorious student since childhood, she completed her schooling in Bilaspur and later pursued her education in Physiotherapy from Government Medical College, Nagpur, Maharashtra. During her school years, she served as a CSM in NCC and actively participated in the Scout and Guide movement. In recognition of her academic excellence and leadership qualities, she was honoured by Bilaspur Maharashtra Mandal during her school education.

In 1997, she married Mr. Avinash Vaishampayan, the youngest son of the Vaishampayan family from Raipur. Mr. Vaishampayan is a Civil Engineer and runs a construction business along with Marshal Geo Tech Laboratories, specializing in soil testing. The couple is blessed with two children—Pradnya, an Architect, and Pranav, who is pursuing his B.Tech in Chennai.

Dr. Manjusha Vaishampayan is a proud and dedicated member of the Inner Wheel Club of Raipur Cosmopolitan. A practicing physiotherapist by profession, her passion for serving the community inspired her to join Inner Wheel in 2001. Over the years, she has held several important positions at both Club and District levels, earning numerous accolades for her committed service. Her recognitions include Best ISO, Best Secretary, Best Treasurer, Best President, and the Vibrant President Award. She was also honoured with the prestigious “Unique Service Rendered” Award as Past President, along with appreciation for her contributions as Club Editor and Vice President.

She had the honour of serving as Conference Treasurer for the District Conference Ananya (2015–16) and as Registration In-Charge for the District Conference Jushti (2019–20). During her tenure as Club President, several projects received Best Project Awards, and she successfully hosted the District Seminar “After 40”.

In 2021, she was elected as District ISO (District 326), followed by roles as District Treasurer, District Secretary, District ESO, District Vice Chairman, and now proudly serves as the District Chairman. She received the District



Chairman Achievement Award for each of these positions. Additionally, she was honoured with a Special Recognition Award from the Association of Inner Wheel Clubs in India during her tenure as District Secretary.

Her Inner Wheel journey also includes active participation in the East Zone Meet at Kolkata and Ranchi (2022), where she joined a talk show on Breast Cancer alongside fellow doctors. She attended the Triennial Conference at Varanasi (2021), serving as a Steward, and also participated in the first virtual IIW Convention in the same year.

Beyond Inner Wheel, Dr. Manjusha Vaishampayan is deeply committed to social service. She offers seva at Matruchhaya, a home for orphans, and provides therapy to underprivileged and special-needs patients at her clinic. She has worked extensively with mentally challenged and differently-abled children.

For her contributions to society, she has received special recognition from Maharashtra Mandal, Raipur, and Jain Terapanth Mahila Mandal for her work in senior citizens' welfare. She is also associated with Vanvasi Kalyan Ashram, where she contributes towards preserving Indian culture and supporting rural education.

Her hobbies include gardening, painting, and reading spiritual texts. Spiritually inclined, she is the first Geetavratini from Chhattisgarh, having memorized the entire Bhagavad Gita. She was awarded First Prize in the recitation of all 18 Adhyayas of the Gita in an examination conducted by Sringeri Math, Karnataka. She serves as a teacher, mentor, and examiner with Geeta Parivar, helping others connect with the timeless wisdom of the Gita. She is also currently studying the Vedas at Bhagwat College, Pune.

Vinutha Harish, a distinguished leader and philanthropist from Bengaluru, Karnataka, brings a dynamic legacy of service, leadership, and empowerment to her role as the Association President of Inner Wheel India for 2026–27. With deep roots in community development and a passion for uplifting women and youth, Vinutha's journey is a powerful example of dedication, compassion, and transformative leadership.

Early Life and Education.

Born on October 9, Vinutha was raised in a family deeply committed to philanthropy and entrepreneurship. Inspired by her grandfather's legacy and nurtured by strong role models, she grew up valuing service, humility, and leadership.

She completed her schooling at St. Theresa Girls School and went on to earn a Bachelor's degree in Psychology from NMKRV Women's College. A multi-talented sportsperson, Vinutha excelled in Kho Kho, Volleyball, Throw Ball, and Badminton, representing her school, college, and the University and State teams. She achieved national recognition in Volleyball and Shooting Ball, earning the prestigious "Kreeda Shree" Award from the Bangalore District Volleyball Association.

Community Service and Social Impact

Vinutha's contributions to social service are extensive and impactful. She co-founded the Rajajinagar Sports and Cultural Association, offering sports training to underprivileged youth. This initiative earned the Arya Bhatta Award for its contribution to grassroots sports development.

In 2001, she established SIFI-I Way, Bengaluru's first women-run Internet center, which she managed for 12 years. Through her venture Atal Computers, she provided free computer literacy training to over 100 SSLC students from marginalized backgrounds.

Her association with Inner Wheel began in 2014, and as President of the Inner Wheel Club of Mahalakshmiapuram (2015–16), she spearheaded several life-changing projects:
